

The Indwelling of the Holy Spirit

Romans 8:1-17

We have a Triune God: God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit. Most of us know who the Father and Son are, but the Holy Spirit isn't as well known as the Father and the Son.

However, the Holy Spirit is the most prominent person of the Godhead in our passage this morning. You will notice His ministry is closely associated with that of the Father and the Son.

At the moment of justification, the Holy Spirit of God indwells the believer. This indwelling of the Spirit affirms God's work in the life of the believer. The Holy Spirit is the seal of the believer's salvation. The indwelling of the Holy Spirit makes eternal security a reality. In our context we see three things that the indwelling of the Holy Spirit does for the believer.

- 1. The indwelling of the Holy Spirit frees us from condemnation.
Romans 8:1-4**

- 2. The indwelling of the Holy Spirit enables us to live pleasing to God. Romans 8:5-11**

- 3. The indwelling of the Holy Spirit gives us a new life. Romans 8:12-17**
