Patient in tribulation
Continuing steadfastly in prayer
Distributing to the needs of the saints
Given to hospitality
Rejoice with those who rejoice
Weep with those who weep
Be of the same mind toward one another
Do not set your mind on high things
Associate with the humble
Do not be wise in your own opinion.

Our Core Values Outside the Church Romans 12:17-21

Bless those who persecute you; bless and do not curse
Repay no one evil for evil.
Have regard for good things in the sight of all men
If it is possible, as much as depends on you, live peaceably with all men.
Beloved, do not avenge yourselves
